Reduced fees for select exhibitions

Our new *early-bird* incentive

Starting this year, if you are among the first to book one of our brand new exhibitions your organization will save 10% on the participation fee!

Here's how it works:

When we launch a brand new exhibition tour, one-half of the booking periods will qualify for a discount of 10% off the participation fee. For a tour of 10 venues, for example, the first five exhibitors to complete their booking by the deadline will be eligible for the discount. The discounted booking periods do not have to be sequential.

If the exhibition is rated **limited** or **moderate** security, you have **three months** to solidify your booking. This means three months to submit all completed AAM facility report materials and, assuming it's approved, to return your signed contract along with the 25% deposit. If the exhibition is rated **high** security, you have **six months** to complete your booking.
